HEALTH CARE ACCESS STUDY

You may qualify if you are:

- o A person with a disability*.
- o At least 18 years old.
- o Have needed health care within the last 12 months.
- o Live in Alaska, Idaho, Oregon, or Washington.

What:

- o The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) sets out guidelines for health care access for people with disabilities or functional limitations due to health conditions or aging.
- o This study aims to capture experiences in accessing health care as it relates to the ADA.
- o Participants will be asked to complete a short eligibility screening questionnaire.
- o The full survey asks about participant's demographics and their experiences in accessing health care.
- o This is a one-time survey that can be completed online, over the phone, or on a paper survey.
- o Participants will be eligible for a drawing of \$50 Amazon eGift cards.

Why:

o The ADA is over 25 years old but barriers still remain. The goal of this research is to find out where those barriers exist and ways of improving access.
